- Therefore, the use of a support decision tool like the SpitFire Platform is essential for a good







- I The operating rooms of the District Commands (CDOS) report at the time by phone, to the operating room of the National Command of all occurrences where intervened Portuguese resources in Spain and vice versa...
- II Occurrence time line :
- a. All interventions means from Spain are recorded immediately by the operations room of the District Command, the occurrence of Support Operational Decision System (SADO), using the entity "SPAIN" b. Whenever the Portuguese resources, intervene in Spain, the District Command opens an occurrence in SADO, making its location in the Spanish territory, recording all the information in it..
- III The operations room of the National Command keeps constantly updated an intervention control map, which must be sent to the Centre for Technical Support and International Relations of the ANPC, the 01 and 15th of each month.
